It is fantastic to see that more and more children are receiving a golden ticket for the school clubs. Due to this higher number we have had to reassess how we offer this. Next term we are going to be running the golden tickets slightly differently than this term. Those 8 will then have priority to sign up for clubs the day before. All children who have not missed any golden time will be printed in the newsletter at the end of this term before the selection is made. If you feel your child should be on this list please make sure you inform your child's teacher BEFORE we break up for Easter. Names of those who have been picked for the golden ticket will then be printed in the newsletter at the start of next term.

Please note the club sign up next term will be on Thursday 4 May at 8.05am – 8.30am and then after school from 3.20pm. Those who are successful and receive a golden ticket will have the sign up on Wednesday 3 May between 3.20pm – 3.45pm. Please put these dates in your diary.

Friday – Year 3 classes




The library is open to all other year groups during Golden Time (Friday 12pm – 12.45pm)
