### **REPORTS TO PARENTS**

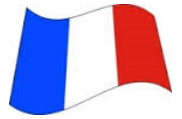

Kids Club HQ, is our bookings and billing system that we have recently started using.

You will now need to add the details of the **regular set days** and sessions that your children will attend the club(s) by 'requesting an electronic copy of your contract'. The process is quite straightforward and the attached document walks you through it, step by step. Set contracted days will be automatically populated each term and billed by the system one week before the end of each month for the following month.

**Bookings for non contracted days/adhoc bookings are made by 'making a booking'. All extra/adhoc sessions must be paid for on booking or in the month in which they are booked.**

**AT THE MOMENT ALL ROTA BOOKINGS AND ADHOC BOOKINGS ARE NOT AVAILABLE ON THE SYSTEM BUT WILL BE SHORTLY. PLEASE EMAIL ME IF YOU WANT A ROTA. ONLY REGISTER FOR YOUR CONTRACTED DAYS**

Any account that is not fully up to date will unfortunately not be permitted to make further bookings.

The contract is the same as the paper one attached which is for your information and does not require completing as you accept the contract and terms and conditions by signing up. (Please read this document carefully and note in particular the notice period for cancellations, the yearly admin fee and any penalties for late payment and pickups) We also attach a copy of our parent brochure with all our policies and procedures in.

You will only need to add your details once and the system will securely retain the information for you. If any of the information changes, you can also update the details the system holds yourself.
