Please note those children who have been attending the Journalism Club after school on a Friday it will be the last one this week (Friday (24 February)).

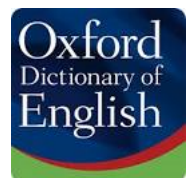
DICTIONARIES

Friday	–	Year 3 classes




The library is open to all other year groups during Golden Time (Friday 12pm – 12.45pm)
