PARENTPAY

As you are aware we have changed onto a new online payment system to bring us in line with most of the high schools so parents will only ever need one online account. All parents have now received a registration letter and should now be registering. New additions to online payments will be clubs and children's university activities so it's vital that ALL parents register. The payment system is now available through the school app as well, the logo on the app says ParentPay. Thank you for your cooperation.



SCHOOL APP

OurSchoolsApp is a personalised app which allows us to keep you all updated with school information, news and calendar events as well as a link to our facebook page. The online payment system is also linked to the app and is available for IOS and Android phones. **It also contains an easy link to access online payments.**



When the app is updated with new information, including the weekly newsletter a push message notification will automatically be sent to your device to inform you.

Instructions for download

1. Using your device (iPhone, iPad, smart pad, tablet or android phone), visit the relevant market place (Apple Store or Google Play)
2. Search for '**OurSchoolsApp**' and download the app
3. Once downloaded, use the search bar within the app and enter the postcode **BB2 6LX** or **school name** and hit search.
4. Once the school name has been displayed, touch the screen on the name and confirm your choice by pressing OK.
5. You will now be presented with the correct app for Wensley Fold. Congratulations!

BIKEABILITY – YEAR 5

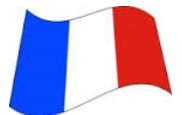
All children who handed in their forms last week, will be taking part in the Bikeability course starting from this Friday 14 September.

Further details will be sent out nearer the time. Children's University is for all children in Years 1 – 6.

CLUB EXHIBITION

Please note the club exhibition will take place THIS Thursday 13 September from 8.05am – 8.30am and at 3.20pm. The sign up for the Golden Tickets will take place THIS Wednesday 12 September (tomorrow) at 3.20pm. Please ensure you have selected a raffle ticket BEFORE the sign up as they will NOT be available on the day.

Please note there is now a slight change for the cost of clubs from this term. Clubs will now cost £5 per club for the term. If you have any free vouchers left from previous terms you will be able to use these for THIS term only.

Please see below points you need to know about the club sign up: -

- You need to attend the Club Exhibition to sign your child up to any of the clubs.
- Raffle tickets will be issued at the office to determine your order in the queue. These must be selected **BEFORE** the sign up by picking a ticket out of the box at the office. Names will then be called out in order on the day. If you do not pick a raffle ticket you will have to wait until all numbers have been called. You need to make sure you are there when your number is called out on the day otherwise you will lose your place.
- Each child can attend a maximum of 3 clubs. Any clubs they have been personally chosen to attend do not count in this 3. If there are any spaces on clubs after the sign up children can sign up to additional ones then.
- **Priority has been given to all children who have received a Golden Ticket. Their names were printed in the newsletter last week and have a priority sign up tomorrow (Wednesday) at 3.20pm. They also have to select a raffle ticket at the office.**
- Vouchers for the clubs **must** be bought before the club exhibition. Please make sure you buy your vouchers **before** the sign up as you will not be able to purchase them on the Thursday morning. Please note clubs now cost £5 per club. If you have any free vouchers left over from previous terms you can use them up this term only.
- Parents can only register their own children onto the clubs; however Key stage 2 children can sign up for their own clubs.
- If you are signing up at the morning session please make sure you do not leave your child until the bell has gone for the start of the school.
- Some clubs are invite only. Children who have been selected for these clubs will receive a separate letter.

- We do not have waiting lists. A reserve list will be taken for 4 children only but will NOT be carried over to next term. If any child drops out of a club a phone call will be made to these children.
- All children are expected to follow the club contract and any misbehaviour will result in them not being able to attend clubs and their place going to a child on the reserve list.
- Please note Key Stage 1 lunchtime clubs are now only on a Friday lunchtime due to this being an extended lunch.
- **Please note cross country and netball will be FREE. Children still need to sign up for this at the Club Exhibition but no voucher will be needed.**

These will be taking place tonight. All children will be informed by tomorrow whether they have got a place or not.

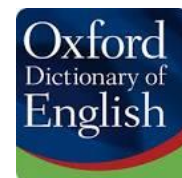
DICTIONARIES
