NEW MENU

In response to feedback from parents we have introduced some changes to our lunch menu, these are an additional main meal choice and a Grab Bag option, the grab bag option will include a sandwich, yoghurt, packet raisins/dried fruit and a biscuit, however please remember that infant children can only have the sandwich option once a week as currently. PARENTPAY & ONLINE LUNCH ORDERING
