MAY DAY HOLIDAY

RAMADAN

We are aware that the majority of our families will soon be preparing for the month of Ramadan. Our staff do not have time to contact parents to check. In cases where a letter has not been received, children will be asked to continue with normal lunchtime arrangements. RETURNED LIBRARY BOOKS

Please ensure that books are returned to school in the correct way so that they can be marked as returned by your child on the system.

At **KS1**, books are returned to the library basket in the classroom or brought to the library session. At **KS2**, Books are returned in the Return box by the lift or brought to the library session.

Books **MUST NOT** be returned to the shelf by the child. If this happens, you may be charged for the book as it has not been marked as returned on the system.

YEAR 5 TRIP MANCHESTER SCIENCE & INDUSTRY MUSEUM

CLUB SIGNUP

The golden ticket sign up went live this morning. All golden ticket children have priority sign up until tomorrow morning. Please note the sign up for all other children will go live tomorrow morning (Wednesday) between 7.30am and 7.45am. The clubs need to go live individually, so they will not all come on at 7.30am. Please keep checking during these 15 minutes.

A few key points are: -

- ALL sign up needs to be done through ParentPay.
- Once a club is full it will disappear from ParentPay
- Clubs cost £5 per club per term
- If the club is FREE sign up still needs to be done on ParentPay
- Each child can attend a maximum of 3 clubs. Any clubs they have been personally chosen / selected to attend do not count in the 3. If there are any spaces after 3pm on Thursday 2 May you can sign your child up for additional ones then.
- You MUST indicate on PARENTPAY if you want your child to walk home from the clubs. This is only for those in year 4 and above.
- If you cannot find a club you are looking for this will probably mean that it is already full.

- The system may be slower if everyone is trying to access one club at the same time, please keep trying much the same as Ticketmaster!
- Please bear with us if any problems do arise as these will be addressed if and when they occur.
