EID

We are aware that all our Muslim families will be celebrating Eid on either Sunday or Monday, please can we remind parents that if their child is celebrating on Sunday then they must be in school on Monday otherwise it will be classed as an unauthorised absence, if their child is celebrating on Monday they can only have **1** day off as an authorised absence. May we take this opportunity to wish all our Muslim families Eid Mubarak in advance. Thank you.

FIDGET SPINNERS

We have been very lenient in allowing our children to bring fidget spinners into school to be used at break times, however there have been issues recently with children swapping and even selling their spinners in school. Some time ago the children were spoken to about having fidget spinners in school, about what was and what was not appropriate. It was made very clear that as soon as someone broke the rules then we would have no hesitation in banning them from school. Unfortunately there have been at least 2 incidents that have led us to make the decision to ban fidget spinners with immediate effect - any child caught with a spinner in school will have them confiscated, staff will speak to all children about this in assembly on Thursday. If they are brought into school they will be taken by the class teacher and the child's name will be moved in in our traffic lights. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.

OurSchoolsApp is a personalised app which allows us to keep you all updated with school information, news and calendar events as well as a link to our facebook page. The online payment system is also linked to the app and is available for IOS and Android phones.

When the app is updated with new information, including the weekly newsletter a push message notification will automatically be sent to your device to inform you.

Instructions for download

1. Using your device (iPhone, iPad, smart pad, tablet or android phone), visit the relevant market place (Apple Store or Google Play)
2. Search for '**OurSchoolsApp**' and download the app
3. Once downloaded, use the search bar within the app and enter the postcode **BB2 6LX** or **school name** and hit search.
4. Once the school name has been displayed, touch the screen on the name and confirm your choice by pressing OK.
5. You will now be presented with the correct app for Wensley Fold. Congratulations!

As part of their DT in Year 3, please can children bring in any shoe sized boxes – House points will be given.

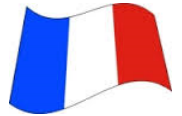


BETTER READING
