Activities

Cooking – Children will have the opportunity to do some cooking which they will take home. *Children can only sign up to only **ONE** of these sessions.*

During the day they will work with the programming language such as Python. They will also learn how to code a website and have a conversation with their computer. Children will also bring some crafts home that they have made.
