# Information on School Clubs - For Parents / Carers

Please see below some information on how clubs are run at Wensley Fold Primary Academy.



## When do school clubs take place?

They can be at lunchtime or after school and they are open to all children in Years 1 – 6. They run for between 8 and 10 weeks depending on the length of the term. They normally start the 3<sup>rd</sup> week into a new term with the sign up being the week before.



## What happens during the first week back of a new term?

This will be in September, January and April. Information will go out to parent / carers on what clubs are available. This includes the day each club is on and also what year groups it is open to. **All information will be sent through the Schools App and the newsletter.**



## Golden Tickets

To qualify for a **Golden Ticket** your child must not have missed any golden time throughout the previous term as well having **100% punctuality** and at least **96% attendance**. All names of those who have qualified for a Golden Ticket will be printed in the newsletter during the first week back of the new term. The school should be informed by Friday of the first week of the new term if any parent / carer feels like their child should have qualified but their name hasn't been printed.



## Sign Up

These normally happen during the **second week** back of the new term. The sign up for clubs will now be done through **PARENTPAY**. Clubs will be available for **Golden Ticket** children from 7.30am on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> January. Then the sign up for all other children will go live at 7.30am on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> January.



## Old club vouchers

If any parents / carers have any vouchers left over from previous terms they will be able to receive a refund for these. Refunds will be issued once a club has been paid for on PARENTPAY. All old vouchers must be brought to the office and given to Mrs Ghiwala during the first week of clubs starting. This will be anytime from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> January to Friday 25<sup>th</sup> January. A refund will then be issued. No FREE vouchers can be exchanged; it will only be those that have £5 on. **Old club vouchers can only be refunded for this term only.**

## How much do clubs cost?

Clubs cost £5 per club per term. Sign up and payment **MUST** be done through PARENTPAY. A couple of clubs may be free; however sign up must still be done through PARENTPAY. Details of any free clubs will be indicated on the club information sheet at the start of the new term.



## Number of clubs

Each child can attend a **maximum of 3 clubs**. Any clubs they have been personally chosen / selected to attend do not count in this 3. If there are any spaces on clubs after 3pm on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> January you can sign your child up for additional ones then. Children can only attend Let's Get Cooking and Gymnastics once over the academic year unless there are still places after 3pm on Thursday.



## Club Confirmation

All children who have signed up for clubs will receive a confirmation letter in class. This will indicate what club(s) they have signed up for, as well as if they need to bring anything specific to the club.



## Walking home from clubs

All children must be collected by a responsible person who is over 11 years of age from the school office. Please note that once the child is dismissed from the club the child is then the responsibility of their parent / carer. Please note that if your child is walking home they have to be 8 years or older and you **MUST** have indicated this on PARENTPAY when signing them up. **However we would prefer all children to be collected from the clubs, especially with these dark nights.**

Club	Year Groups	Day and Time	Brief Description of the club
French Club	Year 2	Monday 11.40am – 12.15pm	Children in year 2 will develop their French Skills. Over the year every year 2 child will attend this club. <i>Selection will be done in class for this.</i>
Stitch and Sew Club	Year 3 and 4	Monday Lunch 12.30pm – 1pm	During this club children will develop their sewing skills. They will learn how to cut fabric, make patterns and sew. <b>This club is for those who have not done it before.</b>
Debating Club	Year 5 and 6	Monday and Wednesday	<b>Sign up done in class for this.</b> If your child is unsure please ask them to check with Mrs Mercer.
Young Librarians Club	Year 3 and 4	Monday 3.10pm – 4pm	During the club children will learn about running a library. They will be part of the team running the library - issuing and returning books, helping people using the library, shelving books, tidying the library, promoting the library and books and using computers. Some children from year 5 and 6 have also been invited to this club
Multi Sports	Years 3 - 6	Monday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will cover a variety of sports over the 9 weeks.
Multi Skills Club	Year 1 and 2	Monday 3.10pm – 4pm	During this club the children will develop their sports and coordination skills through fun games and activities.
Games Club	Years 1 - 3	Monday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will be able to play a variety of games including fun board games with other children.
Art Club	Years 1 - 4	Monday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will develop their art skills and make a variety of things.
Circuit Training	Years 5 and 6	Tuesday Lunchtime 12 – 12.30pm	Children will take part and have a go at a variety of fitness circuits.
Boccia	Years 2 - 6	Tuesday Lunchtime 12.30pm – 1pm	<b>Those from last term</b>
Football Club	Year 5 and 6	Tuesday 3.10pm – 4pm	<b>Those from last term. Please make sure you sign up online if your child took part last term.</b>
Netball Club FREE	Year 4, 5 and 6	Tuesday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will learn the rules and skills of netball and put these to practice during games. <b>This club will be FREE, however you do still need to sign up online.</b>
Fun Fitness Club	Year 1 - 4	Tuesday 3.10pm – 4pm	During this club children will do lots of team games, try hula hoops, skipping, fun games, races and parachute games plus much more!
Make it!	Year 3 and 4	Tuesday 3.10pm – 4pm	During this club children will try cross stitching, making gift bags, cards and just being creative! Some things may be repeated from last term.
Debating Club	Year 3 and 4	Tuesday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will look at how to speak in front of an audience whilst putting their opinions across fluently and confidently. Some children have been invited to this club, however places are still available.
Dodgeball Club	Year 3 - 6	Wednesday Lunch 12 – 12.30pm	<b>This club is an invite only club.</b>
Key Stage 1 Creative Club	Year 1 and 2	Wednesday 3.10 – 4pm	Children will do a variety of activities at this club. They may include stories, games, mini crafts and much more. This club is a very creative club where children will try lots of different things. Some things may be repeated from last term.
Media Club	Year 3 - 6	Wednesday 3.10 – 4pm	Look at films and photography and how they are created from start to finish.

Club	Year Groups	Day and Time	Brief Description of the club
Drawing and Painting Club	Year 4 - 6	Wednesday 3.10pm – 4pm	Over the weeks children will develop their art skills, looking at creating an art portfolio.
Homework Club	Year 3 - 6	Wednesday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will have the opportunity to complete their homework and have support if needed.
Chess Skills	Year 2 – 6	Wednesday 3.10 – 4pm	The children in the chess club will learn about the rules of chess as well as how to play the game. They will learn how to play a competitive game. <b>Priority will be given to those from last term.</b>
Mindfulness and Wellbeing Club	Year 5 and 6	Thursday Lunch 12.30pm – 1pm	During this club children will develop strategies for their own wellbeing through activities such as yoga, colouring and meditation. Some children have been invited to this club, however places are still available.
Sing with Hands FREE	Year 3 - 6	Thursday Lunch 12.30pm – 1pm	Children will sing popular songs using Makaton and their voices. <b>This club will be FREE, however you do still need to sign up online.</b>
Coding Club	Year 3 - 6	Thursday 3.10 – 4pm	Want to learn the language of the computer? Want to learn to make your first computer programs? Coding Club is for you. This club will be fun and help you learn new skills!
Ball Games and Sports Club	Year 3 - 6	Thursday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will learn the skills of a variety of different ball games. The club will be run by a member of staff from Blackburn Rovers Community Trust.
Apple and Sphero Club	Years 3 – 6	Thursday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will learn how to use the ipad and learn new things which will include the sphero.
Film Club	Year 1 - 4	Thursday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will select and watch a couple of films and then complete activities around them. Either U or PG films.
Debating Club	Year 1 and 2	Thursday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will start to develop their debating skills. They will look at child friendly stories and traditional tales.
ICT Club	Year 1 and 2	Friday Lunch 12.30pm – 1pm	Children will use this time to go on the computer or an iPad. During the session they will try and use a variety of educational games.
Get Active – Dance Fitness	Years 1 and 2	Friday Lunch 1pm – 1.30pm	Children will learn fun routines and dances to different songs whilst being active.
Gymnastics	Year 1 and 2	Friday Lunch 1pm – 1.40pm	Children will learn gymnastic skills from a Gymnastic Coach. <b><u>Please note children can only do this club once throughout this school year. Unless there is space after the sign up.</u></b>
Let's Get Cooking	Years 3 - 6	Friday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will learn basic cooking skills and healthy eating. <b><u>Please note children can only do this club once throughout this school year. Unless there is space after the sign up.</u></b>
Gymnastics	Year 3 - 6	Friday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will learn gymnastic skills from a Gymnastic Coach. <b><u>Please note children can only do this club once throughout this school year. Unless there is space after the sign up.</u></b>
Cheer Dance	Year 1 - 6	Friday 3.10pm – 4pm	This club will be a mixture of cheerleading moves and street dance. Children will use a variety of moves and will create a fun routine performed to music.
Football and Cricket	Year 3 and 4	Friday 3.10pm – 4pm	Children will develop their football and cricket skills with a football coach from Blackburn Rovers Community Trust.
