## **PARENTPAY & ONLINE LUNCH ORDERING**

A message was sent out via OurSchoolsApp last week advising parents that we reverting back to the normal system of booking meals on ParentPay. Please can we remind parents that they have just before midnight **TONIGHT** to order their child's lunches for next week, (week commencing 28 September). Please note, if you have not booked your child's lunches for the following week, the school office will order a lunch for them, which might result in your child not eating their preferred meal choice.

Parents that are new to the booking system, please note children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 are only allowed to have **1** Grab bag a week.

Please can all parents ensure that they only book one dessert a day. Thank you.

## **SCHOOL MEAL PATTERNS**

Your child must be on a school meal pattern or packed lunch pattern for the WHOLE TERM. If you wish to change your child's meal pattern, please notify the school office by the end of the week.

## **SOCIAL DISTANCING - PARENTS**

Please can we remind parents that they must not socialise on the school grounds and should maintain a 2 metre distance away from other parents, if this is not possible then a mask must be worn. Can we also remind parents that only 1 adult should be dropping off and collecting their child. We have worked hard in school to try and protect your child and all we ask is that parents support us by following the rules. Thank you.

## **EUROPEAN LANGUAGE DAY**

We are holding a European Language Day in school next Monday 28 September focusing on the country Spain. Children will be taking part in Spain related activities. Children can come into school dressed in the colours RED and/or YELLOW (no football shirts or jeans please).

If your child has PE on Monday, then they must come to school dressed in their PE kit, but can wear a red and/or yellow t-shirt.

### **BEDTIME READER BOOKS – YEAR 1**

If any children in Year 1 still have a Bedtime Reader book from Reception class last term, please can they send it into school as soon as possible.

### **BREAKFAST CLUB**

If you wish your child to attend Breakfast Club please make sure you have informed the office by this Thursday. Please remember that payment must be made in advance on ParentPay.

### **RECEPTION – YEAR 6 FLU VACCINATIONS**

An email detailing information regarding the nasal flu vaccinations for all children in school was sent to parents **last week**. If you would like your child to receive the nasal flu vaccine in school on Thursday 8 October, please follow the link in the email, to complete the online consent form.

### **VISION SCREENING – YEAR 1**

An email detailing information regarding vision screening for all children in Year 1 was sent to parents **last week**. If you would like your child to **opt out** from the vision screening test, please contact the school office.

### **MILK**

Milk money is now due for the Autumn Term for all infant children; however all Reception children will receive free milk up to the term in which they have their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday. Please can parents of children in Reception, Years 1 and 2 pay £12 online for this academic year. Thank you.

### **RECEPTION FUND**

As mentioned in your Reception induction booklet, throughout the year, children will have the opportunity to sample new foods and to bake. We ask for a contribution towards the cost of baking and other consumable items of **£5.00** each half term. This money is paid directly to the school office, please can parents of children in Reception send in £30 (for the full year) in a sealed envelope in their child's book bag. Thank you.

### **PRIMARY SCHOOL ADMISSIONS 2020**

If your child's 5th birthday is between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022 you need to make arrangements **NOW** for admission in September 2021. You must now apply using the online application at [www.blackburn.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.blackburn.gov.uk/admissions). The closing date for the applications is **15 January 2021**.
