NEW COVID GUIDELINES

From Monday 17 January, the 10-day self-isolation period for people who record a positive PCR test result for COVID-19 has been reduced to **5** days. Individuals may now take LFD tests on day 5 and day 6 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 5 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education or childcare setting from day 6.

NO MOBILE PHONES

A big focus for us this year at Wensley Fold is developing quality 'speaking and listening' at every opportunity. An important part of this is a child speaking about their day with a parent after school. In order for this to happen we ask that you put mobile phones away before picking up your child. Please don't be offended if we ask you to put your phone away whilst in school, we are working together to develop everyday speech and language. Thank you for your co-operation.

SCHOOL MEAL INCREASE

Please be aware that as of 18 April 2022 there will be a 5p meal increase applied by Dolce, due to rising inflation and minimum wage increases. The new weekly amount will be £11.25. Thank you.

MAIN GATE

Please can parents **NOT** use the main gate for entering and exiting the school grounds even if it is open, it prevents the gates from closing and allows cars access to the grounds. This is a safeguarding issue when there are many children on the drive. Thank you for your cooperation with this matter.
